

Fostering a culture that values education and learning is more than just a commitment at EACOM: we made it part of our most fundamental values. We believe it is important to encourage youth to pursue their dreams and to set goals for the career they see themselves evolving in.

This program provides financial support (\$1,000) to Aboriginal students pursuing a post-secondary education in forestry or business. Scholarships will be provided to individuals that exemplify the qualities of strong academic standing and commitment to their field of study.

Eligibility

To be eligible to receive a scholarship, the candidate:

- Is aged between 16 and 25;
- Is currently enrolled full-time in a post-secondary study program in forestry or business;
- Demonstrates strong academic standing;
- Demonstrates a commitment to their field of study beyond academics, for example by volunteering or working in the forest products industry or in business, or by showing a recommendation letter from a member of their community;
- Is entitled to work and study in Canada;
- Is a member of a First Nation or Métis;
- Resides in Ontario or Quebec.
